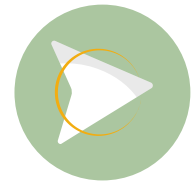

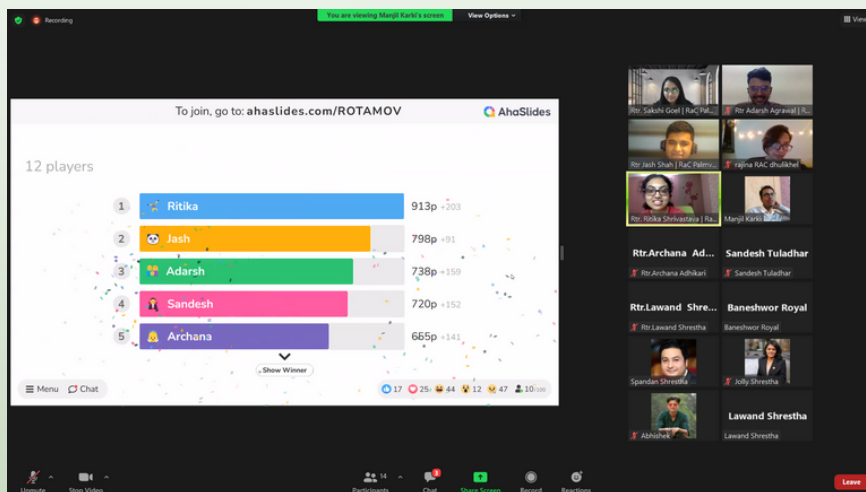

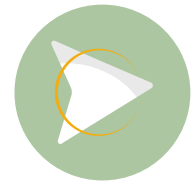
JOINT MEETING
